All-inclusive tickets are \$99 for a father and one daughter. Additional tickets for daughters can be purchased for \$40. Dance only tickets are \$25 for adults and \$20 for children under 18. Check-in begins at 10 a.m. at Piper's Opera House where all-inclusive ticket holders receive a package with goodies and instructions on where to redeem lunch, treats and more. Dance-only ticket holders also must check-in at Piper's Opera House before their designated dance time.
